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Seminar Aims

This seminar is designed to:

- Give delegates a deeper understanding of leadership character.
- Challenge limiting mindsets and encourage positive change.
- Generate greater self awareness and authenticity
- Provide a development framework for further success in leadership

Seminar Objectives

By the end of this seminar, using any support materials available, delegates will be able to:

- Define three internal and two external character attributes exhibited by excellent leaders.
- Understand the important division of time and their responsibility for its effective use.
- Identify their personal brand together with initial improvement steps.
- Define three key thinking methods that enable the forward development of themselves as leaders.
- Begin their own journey of leadership discovery

Target Audience

- Any management person with responsibility for influencing business direction and guiding others in achievement of goals and objectives.
- Individuals wanting to gain a better understanding of the characteristics they need to apply that will enable them to grow as leaders.

Duration

Seminar Outline

Anyone attempting to analyse leadership often does so by looking at an individual's popularity, power, wisdom in long term planning and charisma. However excellence in leadership, whilst perhaps having a degree of these attributes, is really about application of a number of character keys which unlock an ability to lead.

This seminar explains the characteristics of leadership and helps delegates to recognise and engage in positive change. The timetable is structured to allow participants the opportunity to learn about themselves and how this can affect their leadership style. The seminar consists of a mix of theory and practice designed to help participants grow in confidence and their ability to lead.
